On November 12-13, the ASNJ, in partnership with the Edison Greenways Group, Edison Township, and the Middlesex County Office of Arts and Culture, will be conducting an archaeological open house in the Piscatawaytown Burial Ground next to the St. James Episcopal Church, at 2136 Woodbridge Avenue in Edison, Middlesex County, NJ. There, we will be looking for the remains of a mid-19th-century school and a late 17th-century town hall. A public open house will take place on November 13 between 1:00 and 3:30 pm and will consist of site tours. Site parking will be on Germantown Avenue, behind the church.

Volunteer opportunities are available to <u>current ASNJ members</u> who would like to get their hands dirty, help dig and look for artifacts at one of the state's oldest town greens.
